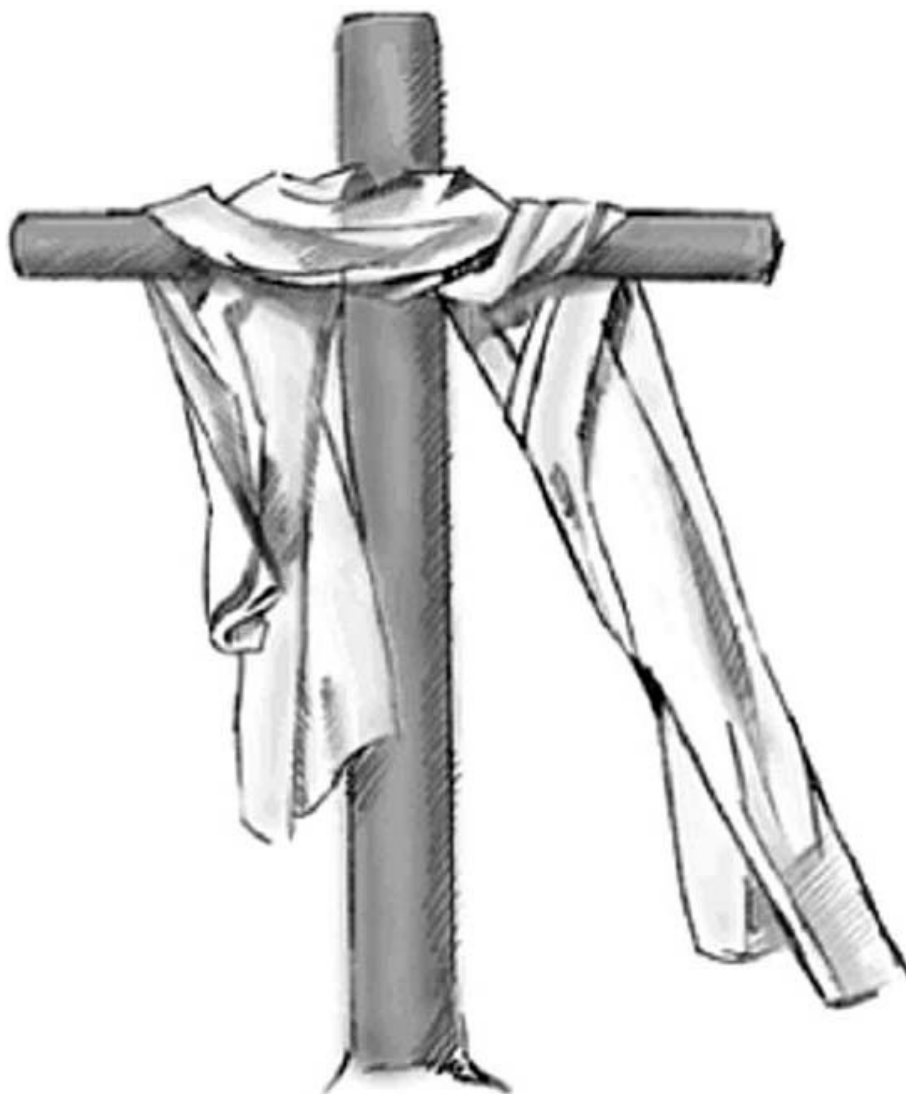

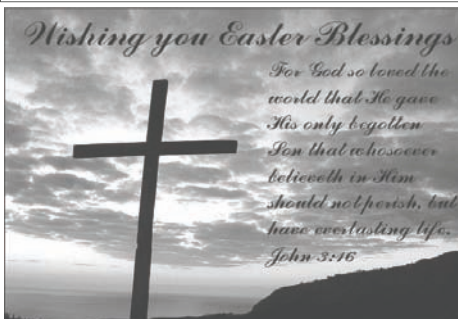

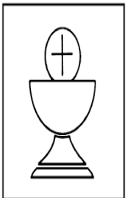
Confirmation Retreat
