Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday leading up to the Spaghetti Dinner were busy times in the Hall. People were coming and going, slicing and dicing, stirring and chopping, buttering and rolling, and a myriad of other activities all in preparation. The tickets were sold out rather early which is a very unusual occurrence. Our parish certainly is not immune to the society of last minute deciders. As the phone call inquiries came in, we mentioned that it was sold out but come anyway and we should be able to squeeze you in. It wasn't so much that lack of room, though wall to wall pasta eaters was a sight to behold, it was having enough salad, garlic bread, spaghetti and of course sauce. As I am not a great connoisseur of any food really, my suggestion of making sure that we have some extra cans of spaghetti sauce, and a bag of M 7 M's meatballs, just in case, was met with scornful glares, tsk tsk, and derisive shakes of the head. The outstanding sauce chefs absolutely refused to mix their delicious homemade concoctions, stirred and seasoned with years of experience with something as pedestrian and non-descript as store bought sauce and meatballs. The blasphemy! I was lucky to escape with my life as some of the chefs were brandishing sharp knives. With the deterioration of some of our aged well-used wooden tables, for a couple of years we have been talking about replacing them. Apparently there is this new material that is durable and much lighter than the heavy, cumbersome wooden tables. It is called plastic. So the sold out event was the perfect time to begin this process. We ordered ten new plastic tables and we were assured that they would arrive on the Friday before the event. Then around 4:30 knowing that their deliveries usually finish at 5 pm, we put in another, somewhat desperate call and again we were assured that they would be here. They would let us know within 24 - 48 hours. I explained that we needed them before the 24 hour mark or we would have 80 people at a banquet with no place to put their plates and we had people waiting around to help set the tables. At 5:30 I called again asking if there was a remote possibility that they might still arrive, but they had no idea and no way of contacting the delivery department except through email and since it was after 5 pm, they would be closed anyway. Needless to say they did not arrive. Well, we made due and no one was worse for wear, though I exceeded my 10,000 steps on my fitbit pacing and fretting. The tables arrived on Monday, promptly at 2 pm and the driver informed us that this truck wasn't out on Friday. Go figure.

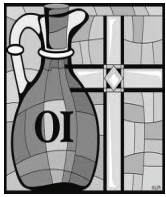
