The technician arrived about 20 minutes late so I had the intention of cleaning the abundance of weeds around the house. The grass hadn't been cut yet and so the growth was extensive. When he did arrive he began by saying that his wife knows all of us. So of course the conversation was directed to all those students back at St. Charles school. His wife was in my younger brother's class. Anyway, there was no furniture in the house to sit on so I went back to weeding, pulling raspberry canes, dandelions, little pine trees, and golden rod. Who knew that so many weeds could be contained in such a small space? It was a beautiful morning, and all the birds were chirping. I guess I have been living in such urban spaces for so long, that I forgot about the natural orchestra that I grew up with. I heard red wings, finches, orioles and cardinals filling the air.
