

Ruminations...

Living in Sudbury for four years during my university days, traveling back and forth, and with my years in the northern part of the diocese, and my many other travels in what we southerners call northern Ontario, (and my humblest apologies to those from north of Sudbury in the real north), my one disappointment was never seeing a moose in the wilds. I do have a friend who hit a moose while driving at night and has been rendered quadriplegic, one of the real dangers of these large beasts, but my hope was always to see one from a safe distant so my car remains intact, but close enough that I could consider it a true encounter. Well, as I was exploring something to do on a day off, I read that one of the best times to see moose in Algonquin Park is in the spring as they emerge from the bushes to lap up the salt from the roads. So I got up early and left for the drive to Algonquin in the hopes of maybe seeing one. It was a cool, but sunny day and after a two and a half hour drive I arrived at the Welcome Centre. The cashier assured me that there were lots of moose sightings over the last several days. I was just going to drive and see what happened. About ten kilometers in I saw several cars on the side of the road, so I slowed to see what was happening. One of the tourists (actually I described him as the stupid tourist) who had no appreciation of my sense of reverence for the scene, nor my necessity for silence, blurted out for all to recognize his stupidity, stated that he thought the moose was fake, a stuffed replica placed there for the tourists. I offered a silent prayer Nature as an apology for his...whatever. Finally the moose emerged from the bush and moved down into the grassy knoll. Not sure if my new friend thought it was an animatronic



moose and was preparing to do tricks for us. Anyway, I saw two more moose that day, and a beautiful red fox. It was worth the trip to A l g o n q u i n . 7r. Roy




