One of my favorite things about a long weekend, is that it is a time for catch-up- maybe a little extra sleep or stay up a bit later or even just reading. Generally the phones are not going, and no one is knocking on the door. Any chore that is undertaken can be done with a casual, relaxed pace. This past long weekend was a time to get digging. The spring weather had been rather uncooperative and so many outdoor projects were behind a self-imposed schedule. Now that the kitchen is almost complete (I am typing this while on retreat so I have no idea what is happening back at the rectory – it may be done for all I know) it was time to confront the issue that precipitated the renovations, the drainage and the garden at the side of the house. In some way it was a happy circumstance. For a couple of years I had been hoping to create a garden along the fence on the south side, mostly because it was a pain to cut the grass there, and little furry critters kept sneaking in under the fence and digging up my backyard. An added bonus was that it would bring a little bit of welcome to that end of the parking lot. So spade in hand, and a level and trowel, and measuring tape and most importantly knee pads, I began excavating. Well, it didn't take long before I was on the phone calling for my brother to bring my nephews to help with this grunt work. My brother obliged but joyfully reminded me that with his recent heart attack, he was only truly able to act as site supervisor. As the garden got dismantled the stones were hauled to be assembled in the new garden – kind of a resurrection of sorts. Somebody got me a t-shirt that says "I'm almost 60, I don't have to take this crap". I was so tempted to put it on. Then some recruits came to join in the drudgery, plus they brought home made pierogis. Then there was this great rumbling coming from around the corner. It was a back hoe to help with the excavations and breaking through the almost impenetrable mesh of roots from the various trees in the back yard. I have never been so thankful for mechanization as I was last weekend. What would have taken me likely the whole summer was accomplished in the course of a couple of days. The rocks got moved, the soil got moved and all the plants that had been ordered from Breck's Bulbs got planted. So at the end of the day, covered in sand and dirt, knees aching, back aching, arms aching, sun burned neck aching, I plopped into the couch after a job well done to put my feet up and breathe a sense of satisfaction that only exhausting manual labour can bring. Just then the hospital beeper went off and I was summoned to the hospital. I was tempted to go as is, dirty, in shorts and work boots and sweaty hat head. Instead I dragged myself upstairs and showered. It felt so good and if I didn't have a pressing issue of someone in the hospital, I would still be there. Anyway as I left for the retreat I survived the work, thankful for those kind souls who lent a hand and back and knees and food and machines and proclaimed it a job well done. I have renamed this long weekend Labour Day.


