Ruminations...

As numbers go, this May long weekend was my 57th. One of the peculiarities is that when your birthday is prior to the long weekend, it is like a bonus extra over those whose birthdays are later in the year. My nephew celebrated 2 Easters before he turned one. I can't recall any specific one – they kind of all just blur together into a remembrance of times past. The weather channel says it was one of the nicer one in a few years and who am I to question them. I kind of had one of those 'time has flown by' moments. I was invited to the retirement celebration of a friend of mine. We go back a long way when I was a young younger priest and she was a young teacher just starting out. It was a time of great energy and excitement about the possibilities of our chosen vocations, a time with wide un-trod paths and infinite horizons. She was going to change the world. Her life in education took her in many twists and turns and eventually she aspired toward administration, becoming first a vice principal and eventually principal. She was fantastic in the classroom but she discovered that she had a talent for dealing with children at a different level and of course helping parents to inspire their children in school. I'm not sure about the inspiring part, being involved in education for decades, the teacher/parent dynamic has changed drastically and not all for the better. I have had some interesting encounters with parents who have accused me of lying about what their child said or did, and blamed the principal, teacher and myself of conspiring to pick on their child. Not sure where the shift happened but... The retirement party was in Belleville so after the Sunday masses, I hopped into the car and headed off for the 2 plus hour trek. That gives one a lot of time to reflect, and as I was feeling somewhat guilty for not tending to the necessary tasks at home, like finally getting the patio furniture out, or the gazebo set up, or the vegetable garden dug, or the hedges trimmed, or the Christmas lights off the trees at the front, or the... it was great to be participating in this milestone celebration. Now I already have university friends who have retired from their various careers, but this was my first invite to such an event. So as the miles clicked by, I was reminiscing about my own teachers, some who have died, and many who are still alive and long since retired themselves. No matter how long ago it started, no matter how long the career lasted, the time still flew by. As I left I signed her guest book and in it I invited her to my retirement party in 18 years and 38 days- not that I'm counting. Retirement is just another new beginning.
