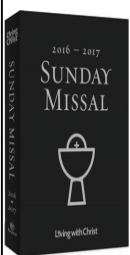

We have a hospital beeper that is shared between the four local parishes, Bradford, Aurora and the two Newmarket parishes. Mathematically each priest gets it for a week, from Tuesday to Tuesday. The three parishes that have two priests get it for two weeks, and how they divvy it up between them is up to them. I get it for one week and there is no divvying it up. It is supposed to be for emergencies only, but sometimes one person's definition of an emergency doesn't quite jive with what the priest might define as an emergency. All in all it is a good system and works well enough, quirks and all. Though this is not my week for the beeper, I was called to assist with an elderly lady not from our parish, but because of this and that, I was called. I had her name and of course, being in a parish where you grew up means that any name can sound familiar and often I begin to wonder if there is a connection from the past or a local flavour that is a conversation starter. Well, this last name evoked some distant memories so I wondered what connections there might be. As I walked into the room, the elderly lady was uncomfortably in bed. Her two daughters were there. They began to introduce themselves but as the one approached me I said that, "You are so and so" (the names have been disguised for their privacy). She was taken aback and said "Yes I am, how do you know me?" I answered that we went to high school together. She still has the same facial structures and eyes so that it was unmistakable who she was. You could see her brain churning trying to figure it out. I was tempted to make her guess who I was, but I myself hate it when someone from the past comes up and asks if I remember who they are. Let's face it, coming up on 40 years means a lot of water has travelled under that bridge. So I mentioned my name and some of the same friends that we hung around with, but there wasn't even the faintest glimmer of recognition – totally great for the ego. I tried to jar her memory wondering if maybe she shouldn't be admitted as an Alzheimer's patient. No story, no classmate brought back any memory of me. That didn't surprise me as I was not a very gregarious person in those years, compounded by the fact that I was a bus student, and my post high school connections were extremely minimal. So the last time I would have seen her was June 15, 1979, my last day of High School. Kind of the story of my life with girls in high school, maybe the reason I became a priest. So anyway, I kind of hope that she went home and dug up one of the five year books we shared. Fr. Ray

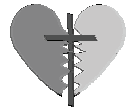
