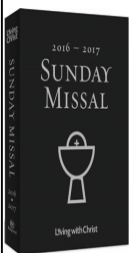

Back when there were way fewer television channels to watch, we were kind of stuck with two, sometimes three channels. One of those boring afternoon shows was the Galloping Gourmet cooking show, where, as history has revealed, the chef became less and less sober as the show went on. Cooking shows were never that popular until the recent rash of reality television. So I have always felt somewhat comfortable in the kitchen. It is kind of easy because I am such a fussy eater that anything with mushrooms, seafood, or meat with bones in it amongst a long list of funny sounding items like eggplant or squash or zucchini, will never make it onto my menu. When the Knights were preparing for their recent rendition of the Chefs' Dinner, I thought I would contribute a dessert. With the number of diners, this means that one batch of anything will not suffice. I opted for a recipe I found on Facebook. It was an oatmeal cookie baked into the shape of a cup, then filled with an apple concoction. I was going to use a variation of the fillings for a bit of variety and had decided to make 5 batches rounding out at about 120 oatmeal cookie cups filled with apple, cherry, peach and blueberry. So after a busy Friday, I headed shopping for ingredients and in the early evening made the assault on the kitchen. I donned my Fish Fry chef jacket, laid all the ingredients in order on the counter and started measuring sugars, flour, oatmeal, cinnamon, nutmeg, vanilla and then Roy's secret ingredients. The first batch didn't go so well. I dropped an entire egg, shell, white and yolk into the mixture. I have never done that, ever! I knew that the recipe called for butter but I didn't see it come up as I followed the instructions line by line. When I pulled them out of the oven, they looked odd, tasted great, but I knew something was amiss. That was when I realized I totally missed the butter. As the night and then Saturday morning went on, the addition of the butter certainly made it better. On the last batch I realized that I was supposed to add the remaining sugars to the filling mixture. I had no remaining sugar. I had added it all to the cookie mixture. Anyway, after Saturday mass I had to rush to Metro for some whip cream. I got there and discovered my wallet was not in my jacket pocket. I rushed back and hunted and hunted for the wallet. It was nowhere to be found. It was odd because I usually keep my wallet in my jacket pocket, so I reached in only to discover that I was not wearing my jacket, I was wearing my chef's coat, both of which are black and both of which have the same cut. Well, the end result was fine, the blueberry cups with the



Cointreau was absolutely exquisite, the peach with vodka was delicious, the cherries were a jubilee, and the apples, and well they were apples. So, there were four batches of great tasting cookie tarts, and one mistake that tasted good too. But let's just say they came out of our own version of "Hell's Kitchen." Fr. Roy
