One of the most enduring Thanksgiving images is the cover of the Saturday Evening post, painted by Norman Rockwell of a family sitting down to a turkey feast presided over by a suited up grandfather with jacket and tie. It certainly speaks of the formality of the occasion. Now our thanksgiving meals were never that formal for which I am grateful. Comfort and relaxed apparel was the style of the day. The only real remembrance of any particular item that I wore was the thanksgiving of my first year of university. Back in the day, there was no such thing as cell phones, or skype. Phone calls were usually restricted for the weekend when the rates were cheaper, and Sudbury was quite the run so weekend visits home were reserved. So for the first time home of course the uniform of the day was everything university. The university jacket, university track pants, university t-shirt and university sweatshirt was the order of the day. Back then in the excitement of coming home, it made youthful sense. Now it just elicits a chuckle and shaking of the head at the exuberance and innocence. I am sure that there are lots of young people home in their first year of university doing the same thing. There was one thanksgiving when there were several neckties at the thanksgiving table. It was the first thanksgiving with my parents' first grandchild. Now our dining room table is a whole other story about the 'discussion' between my dad and I over its size, which to this day is still a running joke. Dad opted for smaller while I was pushing for larger. Dad's house- dad's rules. Just let it be said that I was right and the table should have been the larger one, which my dad even admitted- eventually. So around the table, it never really mattered what one was wearing, but rather what was of the utmost importance was that everyone was there, no matter the age. So the idea of having a separate table for the young ones apart from the rest of us was untenable. Well, my nephew was born at the end of July. Already strategies were being discussed as to what the thanksgiving table would look like. He would have been too young to sit in the high chair, but of course he had to be part of the table, even if he were slumping over. This is where the neckties come in. The high chair was pushed close to the table, and this poor child was strapped in with neckties wrapped all around him. He couldn't have budged if he wanted to, but he was there. Now he didn't eat much at the first thanksgiving 22 years ago, but he has certainly made up for that since. So now as we sit down, crowded elbow to elbow, around an insufficiently sized dining room table, as we survey the



little family that has grown, it truly is an occasion to give thanks, ties or no ties. Happy Thanksgiving.

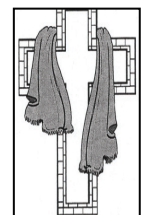
