## Ruminations ....

There seems to be a life cycle for Thanksgiving weekends. Back in the school days, it was met with get excitement about getting a day off school, a long weekend and a shortened week. During high school it had an added bonus of being the last weekend for the drive in. As someone who worked there almost every weekend during the spring and summer, it was nice to have weekends back. The last weekend was of course the all-nighter or almost an all-nighter. With the sun setting so early, the movies could start around 7 pm and be finished earlier than the summer events but you were still crawling into bed in the early hours of the day. When university years came, it was a bit more of a chore, not that being at home was bad, it was just that it took a long time to catch the bus from Sudbury to get to Barrie to be picked up. It was easily a full day's endeavour and the whole journey needed to be repeated on the Monday. In the seminary it was a great break from the structures and routines that comprised our days, and as a priest it was always great to just go home and let down. Unfortunately home sometimes got the brunt of the stresses and strains of the priestly life because the guards could all come down. Mom and dad understood that part of it. And when nephews and nieces began to appear, thanksgiving visits got way more interesting and fun and an event to look forward to. I still remember the first thanksgiving with mom and dad's first grandchild. That poor kid was less than three months old and he was strapped and tied with ties and belts into the new high chair that his grandparents had purchased for just such an occasion. A couple of decades later and he still has a bit of a tilt in his head and I swear it is the result of mom making him sit up for dinner. My dad never wanted there to be two tables, one for the grownups and one for the kids. Let's face it, the action at the table was much more interesting an entertaining with the five of them around even if we were crowded elbow to elbow. I think my dad knew that they added to the uniqueness and completeness of our family. He was very wise that way. Even now, a couple of years since we last gathered around that particular table, in that old home, there is just something so satisfying and mystical about surveying that next generation. Mom is the last of the wise old generation and with her dementia, she must be content with her own memories wherever they may be. In them, I am sure she replays those wonderful memories of



thanksgivings gone by, of the return of university students, and seminarians and the new additions of sisters-in-law. I hope she knows that she was one of the significant things for which we gave thanks and still do. Happy Thanksgiving.
