

Thanksgiving memories always seem to include typical autumn activities. Back in a more civilized time when the weekend was not so rushed, and when everything seemed to shut down for a couple of days, meaning there was nothing else to do, weather permitting it became a time to rake leaves, trim trees, and prepare the property for winter. The crisp air was always gloriously incensed with the smell of burning leaves. Hardly anyone burns leaves anymore. Now the streets are lined with big paper bags filled with the raked leaves and the only way to enjoy the aroma of burned leaves wafting through the air is with scented candles. It was also the weekend we would make our way out to the farm and clean up the reforestation that surrounded the pond, collecting twigs and branches that had fallen over the course of the summer. The bugs were gone and the fields were turned over, the wheat and the corn having been harvested, and we amassed several piles of collected debris for burning. We would stand around the fires as they slowly consumed all the organic material. Some years we wore shorts and some years we donned winter clothing, hats and mitts. I was never sure why my grand aunts insisted on making sure the trails were passable because during the summer, the affliction of mosquitoes and bugs made the forest an unenticing adventure. Maybe it was just to have the company and family around which is okay. I don't ever remember celebrating Thanksgiving on the farm. That particular meal seemed the domain of our own home. We did have a tradition of spending many a Sunday meal at my grandparents, with mashed potatoes (and my grandmother made the best mashed potatoes- she would consider it a personal failure if one were ever to find any semblance of a lump in them) carrots, disgusting creamed corn (just a personal commentary on the food, not the way it was prepared) and of course a delicious roast. With Christmas and Easter and Mothers' Day being celebrated at the farm, Thanksgiving was particularly our own day. Baseball was over, and hockey schedules were much more family friendly, it was our day to feast and be family. It was a time for special appreciation of those people most important in our lives. It was where we celebrated who we were the rest of the year. That makes our Thanksgiving table paradigmatic. It is this particular celebration that unlocks for us the deepest mystery of the Eucharist. This is what links our home tables



to the parish table and vice versa. The kingdom of God was often described as a big feast, of people gathering around a table. So if you are gathering near or far, few or many, quiet and peaceful, loud and raucous, in abundance or with little, this is where God has chosen to be revealed, in the midst of a thankful people enjoying the gift of each other.






