

Living in the Landing meant that you always rode the bus to school, except for kindergarten when Mr. Lewis drove us by taxi. There was no other bus service, no GO bus or Greyhound bus. Just plain old yellow school buses for the Catholic kids and the high school kids. Looking out this big old bus windows was like having a front seat view of what was going on in the neighbourhood. We watched in the fall as the fields on the Holland Marsh were being harvested, and in the spring when the fields were being planted. We saw the arrival of the first McDonald's store being built, and we watched as Upper Canada Mass was under construction, and we waited with baited breath for it to be completed and opened. It seemed so large that one wondered how all those stores could survive, but they seemed to. Of course the best store was the A & A Records. It was on what is now the lower level, but back then there was only one level and one axis, north to south. Down one of the exit wings was a new Hair Salon, Andre's. It was of all things, unisex. I had never been to a place where both sexes got their hair done, and it took a lot of coaxing to go into a 'Salon'. We were used to Frank the Barber whose simple technic was to but the right size on the clippers and shave away, and a treat, a box of chicklets, awaited the cooperative customer. But his shop was no more and the convenience of going to the mass rather than traipsing into downtown Newmarket was too tempting, so into Andre's I finally went. Now the receptionist, which was a new concept, starting asking questions that I had never had to confront before. "Would I be getting my hair washed?" "What style was I looking for? " Was there a particular stylist I wanted?" I was going to say that I wanted the barber who cuts men's hair, but in that swanky, posh décor, it seemed a little out of place, and anyway, I am not that forward, so I sheepishly mumbled something. It took a couple of visits before I was comfortable enough to dare to have the hair washing. I don't remember why I decided to treat myself, but as I sat back in the chair, and laid my neck into the cut out basin, there was this amazing rush of comfort as the warm water was stroked through my hair and this wonderful massaging of my scalp as the shampoo was kneaded into my hair. All that came back this morning as I



was showering, the water dropping on my head, gently rubbing my scalp. times when you are under the weather, simple little pleasures bring great delight- being able to take a deep breath unencumbered-rolling over in bed in the cool morning with nothing pressing. Maybe we should treat ourselves a little more with those simple pleasures that we take for granted. Next time I get my hair cut, I think I will get a shampoo too. From the hospital


