

Ruminations

The day of my sixteenth birthday, mom arranged for me to go to Aurora where the transportation office was so that I could take the drivers' test to get my learner's permit. It meant missing the first class at school, and being the avid student (I never missed a day in grade nine except for two days at the beginning of June for my grandmother's funeral – I was miffed that she couldn't have waited a few weeks so I could have had perfect attendance). I was determined to complete it and get back to school for period 2 with Miss Sinclair's English class. I aced the test and with great exuberance signed into school explaining to the attendance secretary what had happened and then proudly strutted into the classroom and handed Miss Sinclair my admit slip. The truth is I had been driving sporadically since grade nine. Whether coming back from a hockey game or being picked up from school, on occasion dad would pull over to the side of the road and told me to drive. Now we always stopped before home to switch positions. Dad didn't want mom to know because, well, you know how moms are. It was our little secret. Being able to drive was not just a rite of passage, it was the only way to get out of the Landing. There were no bus services back then. Since then, I have only had one speeding ticket which happened when I was going 52 km/hr in a recently reduced zone to 40 km. The police were out catching lots of people. It is one of those things that when you have travelled a road so often, familiarity prevents you from seeing the new speed limit. It was the first week of the change and I'm sure that if I wasn't a young punk but rather the codger that I am now, I would have been let off with a warning. My dad was a truck driver and was extremely vigilant about safety. The only bad habit he handed on was an aversion to seatbelts. Dad refused to wear them, not because of any stubbornness but because a colleague of his had been trapped in a burning truck and was unable to unfasten his seatbelt and eventually died as a result of the accident. I consider myself a good and safe driver though I hate backing into parking spaces and I pray that I never have to parallel park. I parallel parked for my driver's test and have never done so again. All this came flooding back this week as my youngest and favorite nephew was studying for his driver's test. He is the last of that generation to make this big step into maturity. Now some of his siblings had

multiple attempts at passing their tests so we gently reminded him that it is a repeatable event. He anxiously went off for the challenge. About half an hour later I received a text that he had passed with flying colours. So fair warning, there is another Roberts out on the roads. I hope he learns safety well, because at my age, I will soon be looking for someone to chauffeur me around.
