Ruminations

So it has been over half a year since the gym next door has moved and some Orthodox Church community has moved in. It took a while to develop a new routine but it just so happened that another facility had opened just across the road in the industrial plaza. It is much, much smaller. They have fewer machines for cardio and the like, but the number of patrons is limited to keep it quaint. I started frequenting it about once a week back in March and arranged for some assessments and testing to develop a program just for me. So they bent me and flexed me and pushed me and they came to the obvious conclusion that I can't bend or flex or stretch very well. They said things like "oh that's not very far" or "that's as far as you can go?" and my favorite was just "hhhhhmmmmmm". I could have saved myself some money and them some time if they had just asked. When they asked me to touch my toes I told them that the ground was too far away. Sometimes these in-shape, super fit people have no sense of humour. There was one machine to exercise shoulders that great flexibility is needed just to get into position to do the motions. Houston, we had a problem. After a couple of minutes of bending and contorting I was finally able to maneuver my body into position but I was so exhausted from the preparation that there wasn't much strength left. The first couple of visits were not encouraging and it was almost an exercise in drudgery and embarrassment to go. I felt that I should preface almost every instruction with "I was once young and in shape you know..." or "there was a time when I could do this much easier and I had more strength." Yeah, yeah, yeah, those young instructors have no idea. The Bruce Springsteen song "Glory Days" kept playing in my head. So the program they devised for me was based on a three day routine, each day for a various group of muscles. Well my schedule or maybe more applicable my wavering or reticent commitment meant that I didn't make it as often as necessary to make it all work. When I did make it, I did the three routines all at once instead of spreading it out over three days. Once the summer arrived however, and the schools closed for the season, there was more time to attend the gym. I got into the rhythm of doing all three routines at a single session, and I started attending every other day. It was great and had wonderful benefits physically and emotionally. Blood sugars dropped for the better. Stress melted away as did a few pounds. Pant size went down a size and a half. And by far one of the best motivations is that most of



the time, I have the whole place to myself. I got so used to having the place to myself that I get somewhat annoyed if another person invades my space. I would let you know the name of this new facility but I kind of like it to myself too much.




