



There were no cell phones or computers to keep in touch with home, so the phone booth was a busy place on Saturdays - the long distance charges were discounted then. So in my exuberance I got to hear the adventures of mom and dad's trip home. They had stopped at Frank Vetere's (a pizza place of old) and as they sat down, the music playing in the restaurant just happened to be Barbara Streisand singing 'Memories" or more properly "The way we were". Apparently mom had a flood of tears and was caught laughing and crying all in one. So for all the students who


