

Ruminations ...

I was asked by a friend to join in a hockey pool in support of her son's hockey team. It is something I do with them every year since I have known that young hockey star since before he was born. Since my memory isn't that great to remember from year to year whether cheque or cash is better, I dropped her an email asking how best to submit the entrance fee. This was the first year that the option had changed. She suggested I scan the entrance form and remit the money via e-transfer. I quickly responded wondering what the heck an e-transfer was; that I had never heard of it and I certainly had no idea how to accomplish such a modern feat. She replied that it was an easy transaction and one could sense the "tsk tsk tsk" oozing from her email. It caused a whole wave of memories about my first bank account that I started way back when at the CIBC in the old Newmarket Plaza, where Giant Tiger is now. I would deposit money from cutting my grandfather's grass. Each week I received a whopping \$3.00 for my efforts which was a huge amount and my dad kept informing my grandfather that it was too much and that he was spoiling me. My grandfather simply responded that it was his money and anyway, that is what grandparents are supposed to do, something my own father exercised on his own grandchildren. I remember my mom teaching me how to fill out the various bank slips, the one for depositing cash and one for withdrawing cash. Once you had neatly printed your account number on the top and tallied the bills, you would stand in line waiting for your turn at the window where the cash and the slip and the bank book was slipped over to the teller. She counted the money and then wrote in pen the deposit and adjusted the balance, stamped it and handed it back to you. It was always so exciting to finish one bank book and get to have a new one. This was the routine all the way to third year university until the small branch bank closed on campus being replaced by an automatic bank machine where money could be withdrawn anytime you wanted, morning, noon and night (not too many people made deposits at university) and you could update your own bank book. It was a marvel of modern technology and way more convenient that the really long line ups of



3,000 students trying to access two bank teller windows. Now cheques can be deposited by a photo from the phone. At the drive through banking machine, I don't even need to enter the amount, the machine reads the amount of the deposit. It is progress for sure, though the verdict is still out on whether or not it is better. Maybe I have enough technology in my life. So getting back to the hockey pool entrance fee, I informed her that the entry is and the fee have been sent snail mail and a cash bill with a little extra for the hockey player to splurge in the high school cafeteria - if and when it gets there.
