As the Church gathers on Holy Thursday evening at 8:00 pm to celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper, the season of Lent ends quietly. As a Church, we leave the season of Lent and begin to celebrate the Easter Triduum, the three most important days in our liturgical year.

THE EASTER TRIDUUM April 17th - April 20th, 2014

We go home in-between to rest, pray and to ponder the mystery of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection.


