## EASTER OR PASCHAL TRIDUUM The Three Days:

#### April 13th, April 14th, April 15th

The Easter, or Pascal triduum (triduum means three) are the most important days of the entire liturgical year. The season of Lent ends when we gather for the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday. It is not possible to find words to adequately explain the importance and significance of the Easter Triduum.

The best way to understand is to join the Church in celebrating the liturgies of Holy Thursday (8:00 pm), Good Friday (12:00 noon or 3:00 pm) and the Easter Vigil (8:30 pm). You are encouraged to set aside regular tasks or routines so that when you are not at church, your family can enjoy time together.

#### FAITH NOURISHMENT:VITAMIN 'F' Preparing Our Hearts to Celebrate The Easter Triduum

On Tuesday April 4th, at 7:15 pm, we shall gather for Vitamin F. This session will be a time of prayer and reflection as we prepare to celebrate the three most important days in the entire Church year.
