CELEBRATING THE SEASON OF EASTER

For fifty days our Church celebrates the great feast of Easter. The Church tells us that the fifty days from Easter to Pentecost are one great feast! These fifty days above all others are the days we sing with fervent joy, Alleluia! RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION

Beginning the fourth Sunday of Easter, children in our parish will celebrate First Communion. The children will sit with their families and participate fully in the entire celebration of Mass. The families have received catechesis on the proper way to receive Holy Communion. It is always good for those of us who come to the table each week to pause and recall the proper way to receive Holy Communion.

In Advent 2011, we began the implementation of the new Roman Missal which led to some changes to our common sign of reverence at Holy Communion. Our common posture and the use of the same ritual gestures are outward signs of our unity during the celebration of Eucharist.

At the time of Holy Communion, when the person in front of you has received Holy Communion and you are in the front of the procession, you will bow your head, the Minister of the Body of Christ will say, "The Body of Christ", you will reply, **Amen**. It is important to note that the only appropriate response is **Amen**. The church expects that **Amen** is said in a voice that can be heard by the Minister of Holy Communion. After saying **Amen**, you will consume the host immediately and if receiving the Precious Blood, you will move to the Minister of the Chalice who will say, "The Blood of Christ", you will reply, **Amen** and take a sip from the chalice. You will not bow a second time, because the act of receiving the Body and Blood of Christ is one ritual gesture (GIRM, paragraph 160). The Canadian Bishops have instructed that our common sign of reverence be a bow of the head. As a sign of our unity, we sing the Communion hymn and remain standing throughout the entire communion procession. We sit or kneel for silent prayer when the priest sits down after Communion.

STEWARDSHIP

"Blessed are they who have not seen and yet believed," Jesus says in today's Gospel. For those who have not seen to believe, however, we must be good stewards of our faith, living it joyfully and sharing it generously. Then, in our time too, "men and women in great numbers" will be "added to the Lord."
