SEEKING VOLUNTEERS

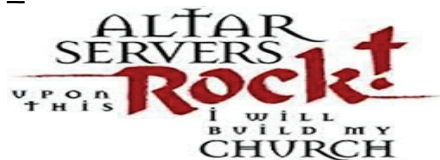
For a NEW Ministry Adults with Disabilities
