PREPARING TO CELEBRATE CONFIRMATION, FIRST COMMUNION and RECONCILIATION

Parents wishing to baptize their children at Holy Family, are invited to approach either Fr. Larry, Fr. Damian, or Deacon Robert, after any of the Sunday masses to obtain a Baptism Preparation Package.

The immediate preparation for the sacraments is the responsibility of the parents and the parish and it takes place at Holy Family Parish. All parents/guardians wishing to prepare their child to celebrate Confirmation, First Communion, or Reconciliation are asked to attend an important information meeting.

BAPTISM FOR CHILDREN IN SCHOOL

Baptism is the first Sacrament we celebrate in the Church and it prepares us to celebrate Confirmation and First Eucharist. If your child has entered school or will begin school in September, 2012 and is **not baptized**, or if your child was baptized in **another Christian Church** (Anglican, Lutheran, etc.) and you would like your child to be a member of the Catholic Church, please call the parish office at 905-857-1938.

It is very important that you attend the information meeting as details will be provided regarding registration, dates for the celebration of the sacraments and future gatherings. All meetings will be held in the church. To accommodate family schedules each meeting is offered twice; you are to attend one of the two meetings. If you have a child preparing to celebrate Confirmation and another child ready to celebrate First Communion, you will need to attend two meetings, as the preparation process is different.
