CELEBRATING BAPTISM

In our parish, we celebrate the sacrament of baptism, the first sacrament of initiation, with parents and their infant children throughout the liturgical year. During the summer months we are able to celebrate baptism during the Sunday liturgy. We are reminded that it is the privilege and duty of all the baptized to prepare and celebrate initiation with new members. During the baptism preparation session we invite the parents to pray using these words:

"We praise God for the miracle of new life. Each time a child is born into the human family, the face of God is revealed to the world. We rejoice with the angels and saints, who sing a song of joy at the upcoming baptism of these children who will become the newest members of God's family. How wonderful that the people of God will be enriched by the addition of these little ones who will grow in God's love and who, one day, will be nourished by the body and blood of Christ." BAPTISM FOR CHILDREN IN SCHOOL

CELEBRATING LITURGY OF THE WORD WITH CHILDREN Sunday August 12th, 10:00 am and 12:00 Noon

In the Directory for Masses with Children, there is an allowance given for us to gather sometimes with children to celebrate the Liturgy of the Word, including a homiletic reflection. At Holy Family Parish, we celebrate a separate Liturgy of the Word with children between the ages of four and eight, at both the 10:00 am and 12:00 noon Sunday liturgies.

There are adult members of our parish who lead the Liturgy with the children. After the Opening Prayer, either Father Larry or Father Damian invites the children to come forward and then they leave in procession with the leaders. The children return to the main assembly and their families during the Preparation of the Gifts. The liturgy of the Word with children will not be celebrated weekly, rather we shall schedule times in harmony with the liturgical calendar and the parish schedule.
