Throughout the season of Lent, we are called to listen more attentively to the Word of God and to set aside additional time for prayer. The traditional Lenten practices of prayer, fasting and almsgiving are to assist us as we prepare to renew our baptismal promise.

In our parish, Kwabina, Kwame, Kwadeem, Cameron and Hailey are preparing to celebrate Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist at the Easter Vigil. Sarah, Grace and Faye are preparing to become full members of the Catholic Church. You are asked to pray for them each day as the time for them to join us at the Eucharistic table draws near.

SUGGESTIONS FOR THE FIRST WEEK OF LENT

The season of Lent is a time of fasting and abstinence. We are called to abstain from eating meat on Fridays and to fast from extra food on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. We may substitute other good actions for abstinence from meat. Good actions may include an act of charity such as visiting the aged, helping those in need by sharing time or money, or other acts of piety including praying the rosary, or spending time reflecting on God's Word.

In the gospel of this Sunday, we read of the Spirit driving Jesus into the desert. Take some time to reflect on what the Spirit is driving you to or from – where is God leading you this Lent?


