PRESENTATION OF THE LORD

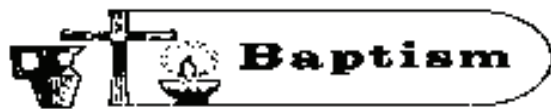

FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD

Today we celebrate the Feast of the presentation of the Lord. This feast is celebrated 40 days after the birth of Jesus. In the Gospel, we hear the prayer of an old man, Simeon, who was promised by the Holy Spirit, that he would not die until he had seen Christ the Lord. As Simeon held the infant Jesus in his arms, he recognized Christ as the light of the world. The words that Simeon says are part of our Gospel Canticle for Night Prayer. Candles may be lit on this feast day as a sign that we are to follow the light of Christ.

The fourth Joyful Mystery of the Rosary is the Presentation in the Temple. As a family, you may mark this feast by praying the Joyful Mysteries of the Rosary.
