ORDINARY TIME

On Monday January 14th, we enter the season of Ordinary Time. The white and gold vestments of Christmas are put aside and we embrace green vestments. Green reminds us of life. This period of time is neither a season of preparation, such as Advent or Lent, nor a season of celebration, such as Christmas or Easter. There are thirty-three or thirty-four weeks of Ordinary Time and this season, especially the Sundays, are devoted to the mystery of Christ in all its aspects.

During the winter span of Ordinary Time, which is very short this year, we will hear from the Gospel of St. Luke. We will celebrate five Sundays in Ordinary Time and then the season of Lent shall begin.

Martin Connell says, "The two spans of Ordinary Time – the shorter one between the end of Christmas and the beginning of Lent, and the longer one between Pentecost and the beginning of Advent, are when the deeds and teachings of the Old Testament, of the early church, and of Jesus of Nazareth are told to nurture, calm, inspire, and animate God's people at worship." (*Eternity Today I*, p. 198).

Gathering each Sunday throughout Ordinary Time shapes and forms as the Body of Christ and we are given the strength to live as the Body of Christ, for the life of the world.


