SUNDAY MASS

COMMUNION AT MASS

Communion procedures are unchanged
despite the lessening of restrictions in
other areas. Both the person
distributing communion and the
communicant must be fully masked.

Once the communicant receives the
Eucharist, they are to move two
meters (six feet) away, safely remove
their mask, consume the Eucharist,
replace their mask, and then proceed
back to their pew.
