

LECTIO DIVINA

As a result of the extensive renovations underway at St. Michael's Cathedral, Lectio Divina with Cardinal Collins will travel throughout the archdiocese in 2015/2016. On Sunday, January 10th, it will be hosted at St. Mary's Parish, 66A Main St. South, Brampton. We hope you will be able to join Cardinal Collins and our faith community.

Lectio Divina ("divine, or sacred, reading") is the name given to a spiritual tradition among Christians over the last two thousand years. This form of prayer involves three distinct stages: a) reading a short scripture passage; b) reflecting on the passage and; c) a short period of silence. We begin with Vespers (Evening Prayer) at 7:00 pm, followed by Lectio Divina from 7:30 – 8:15 pm. All are welcome to join Cardinal Collins for this special evening of prayer. Lectio Divina is recorded by Salt and Light Catholic Media for future broadcast.




