# FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

July 15th, 2012

"Lord, show us your mercy and love, and grant us your salvation."



Parents wishing to baptize their children at Holy Family, are invited to approach either Fr. Larry, Fr. Damian, or Deacon Robert, after any of the Sunday masses to obtain a Baptism Preparation Package.

#### **CELEBRATING BAPTISM**

In our parish, we celebrate the sacrament of baptism, the first sacrament of initiation, with parents and their infant children throughout the liturgical year. During the summer months we are able to celebrate baptism during the Sunday liturgy. We are reminded that it is the privilege and duty of all the baptized to prepare and celebrate initiation with new members. During the baptism preparation session we invite the parents to pray using these words:

"We praise God for the miracle of new life. Each time a child is born into the human family, the face of God is revealed to the world. We rejoice with the angels and saints, who sing a song of joy at the upcoming baptism of these children who will become the newest members of God's family. How wonderful that the people of God will be enriched by the addition of these little ones who will grow in God's love and who, one day, will be nourished by the body and blood of Christ." You are invited to remember in prayer the families who are preparing for and celebrating baptism with their young children.

#### BAPTISM FOR CHILDREN IN SCHOOL

Baptism is the first Sacrament we celebrate in the Church and it prepares us to celebrate Confirmation and First Eucharist. If your child has entered school or will begin school in September, 2012 and is **not baptized**, or if your child was baptized in **another Christian Church** (Anglican, Lutheran, etc.) and you would like your child to be a member of the Catholic Church, please call the parish office at 905-857-938.

#### **ARE YOU A CATHOLIC?**

The preparation process includes prayer, catechesis (teaching) and worship with the parish community.

# PREPARING TO CELEBRATE CONFIRMATION, FIRST COMMUNION and RECONCILIATION

The immediate preparation for the sacraments is the responsibility of the parents and the parish and it takes place at Holy Family Parish. All parents/guardians wishing to prepare their child to celebrate Confirmation, First Communion, or Reconciliation are asked to attend an important information meeting.

It is very important that you attend the information meeting as details will be provided regarding registration, dates for the celebration of the sacraments and future gatherings. All meetings will be held in the church. To accommodate family schedules each meeting is offered twice; you are to attend one of the two meetings. If you have a child preparing to celebrate Confirmation and another child ready to celebrate First Communion you will need to attend two meetings, as the preparation process is different. #### Confirmation

If your child was baptized in the Roman Catholic Church and born in 1999 or earlier, and you wish to prepare your child to celebrate Confirmation, please attend one of the Parent and Candidate Information meetings on;

Tuesday September 18<sup>th</sup>, 2012 from 7:30 – 9:00 pm <u>OR</u> (please note date change)
Sunday September 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2012, from 2:00 – 3:30 pm.

It is very important that you and your son/daughter attend the information meeting because details will be provided regarding registration and future gatherings. If your child was not baptized in the Catholic Church and he or she wishes to be confirmed, please contact Catherine Ecker, parish catechist, 905-857-1938, or by email.

#### First Communion

If your child was baptized in the Roman Catholic Church and born in 2005 or earlier and you wish to prepare your child to celebrate First Communion, please attend one of the Parent Information Meetings on:

Thursday September 27<sup>th</sup>, 2012 from 7:30 – 9:00 pm <u>OR</u> Sunday September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2012 from 2:00 – 3:30 pm

To allow full participation, you are encouraged to arrange child care. If your child was not baptized in the Catholic Church and he/she wishes to celebrate First Communion, please contact Catherine Ecker, parish catechist, at 905-857-1938, or by email.

#### **MEALS HAVE MEANING**

The gospels often describe meals that Jesus shared with other people. He ate and drank with outcasts and sinners. When he was accused of eating with them, he replied that he came to save sinners (Matthew 9.9-13)

Jesus multiplied loaves and fishes to feed the crowds who listened to him (Matthew 14.13-21). On the night before he died, Jesus held a final meal with his apostles, and gave us his body and blood to be our spiritual food in the Eucharist (Matthew 26.26-29). After rising from the dead, Jesus ate with his close followers, who recognized him as their risen Lord (Luke 24.36-49).

Our family meals should be joyful moments when we relax with the ones we love most. Mealtime should not be a period for complaining, arguing, correcting or scolding, but rather a time of joy and peace. Each meal is a further sign that God loves us. God shares the enjoyable things of creation with us, his beloved children. We are nourished by our meals so that we may continue to build God's kingdom and work for his glory. Jesus is with us when we sit down for our meal. He is both our guest and our host. Some families light a candle – on Sundays and special occasions, or at every meal – as a reminder that Jesus is present.

Christians continue to see the deeper meaning of their meals together. They are a reminder of our sharing with Jesus and with one another in the Eucharist, and of our faith that we will share one day in the heavenly messianic banquet.
