STEWARDSHIP

Everybody has talents. Everybody. The question is, are we using these talents? And, are we really using these talents in ways that are suitable for the work of Christ? After all, we all hope to end up with Christ in Heaven with God. But, of course, we're all so taken up with trying to make a living, also. When we bring God into our lives, then we are not working alone any more. We need to remember that we have God there helping us with what we are doing. And, when God is helping us, as St. Paul tells us, then nothing is going to stand in our way. With that in mind, we need to maximize our talents and prevent other obligations from interfering in our eternal goal.

RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION

We continue to celebrate First Holy Communion with children in our parish.. The children will sit with their families and participate fully in the entire celebration of Mass. The families have received catechesis on the proper way to receive Holy Communion. It is always good for those of us who come to the table each week to pause and recall the proper way to receive Holy Communion.

In Advent 2011, we began the implementation of the new Roman Missal which led to some changes to our common sign of reverence at Holy Communion. Our common posture and the use of the same ritual gestures are outward signs of our unity during the celebration of Eucharist.

At the time of Holy Communion, when the person in front of you has received Holy Communion and you are in the front of the procession, you will bow your head, the Minister of the Body of Christ will say, "The Body of Christ", you will reply, Amen. It is important to note that the only appropriate response is Amen. The church expects that Amen is said in a voice that can be heard by the Minister of Holy Communion. After saying Amen, you will consume the host immediately and if receiving the Precious Blood, you will move to the Minister of the Chalice who will say, "The Blood of Christ", you will reply, Amen and take a sip from the chalice. You will not bow a second time, because the act of receiving the Body and Blood of Christ is one ritual gesture (GIRM, paragraph 160). The Canadian Bishops have instructed that our common sign of reverence be a bow of the head. As a sign of our unity, we sing the Communion hymn and remain standing throughout the entire communion procession. We sit or kneel for silent prayer when the priest sits down after Communion


