ORDINARY TIME

On Monday May 28th, 2012, we returned to the season of Ordinary Time. "During Ordinary Time, the Church celebrates the fullness of the mystery of the Lord Jesus. The people of God offer praise by celebrating the Paschal mystery of the death and resurrection of Jesus." (Ordo, Liturgical Calendar, 2010-2011, CCCB, 2010)

Ordinary Time continues until the Church celebrates the Feast of Christ the King, this year on Sunday November 25th, 2012. This period of time is neither a season of preparation such as Advent or Lent, nor a season of celebration such as Christmas or Easter. There are thirty-three or thirty-four weeks of Ordinary Time and this season, especially the Sundays, are devoted to the mystery of Christ in all its aspects.

Sunday is our weekly celebration of Easter. Sunday is the first day of creation, the day of the resurrection and the day that the darkness of death was destroyed forever. The refrain from the hymn *Hail Thee Festival Day*, (words, Venantius Fortunatus (530-609) captures the joy of each Sunday. "Hail thee festival day! Blest day that art hallowed forever; Day when our Lord was raised, breaking the kingdom of death."

Sunday after Sunday, we, the people of God, gather to do as Jesus commanded us. We leave our celebration of the Sunday Eucharist (Saturday evening) strengthened and ready to live once again as disciples of Christ.

The weekly celebration of Sunday Eucharist is a hallmark of a Catholic way of life. Gathering each Sunday throughout Ordinary Time shapes and forms as the Body of Christ and we are given the strength to live as the Body of Christ for the life of the world.

There is nothing 'ordinary' about this time, for like all of time, it belongs to God. As faithful disciples we strive to live our lives rooted in God's presence aware that through the rhythm of daily life we encounter God in the amazingly ordinary parts of our day. Ordinary Time reminds us that our God came and lived among us wedding humanity and divinity forever.

At our family table, during our recreational activities and in our daily work we encounter God active in our lives. As we grow in our awareness of God's creative Spirit in our lives, we come to Sunday (Saturday evening) Mass with a deeper sense of gratitude and joy.


CATHOLIC ESTATE PLANNING Vitamin 'F': Faith Nourishment Tuesday June 5th, 7:30 pm




