PREPARING SCHOOL AGE CHILDREN FOR BAPTISM

Baptism is the first Sacrament we celebrate in the Church and it prepares us to celebrate Confirmation and First Eucharist. PREPARING FOR AND CELEBRATING CONFIRMATION & FIRST EUCHARIST

Throughout the Easter Season, 256 young people were confirmed and 262 children came to the table of the Lord for First Holy Communion. The families were supported in their role as the primary educator of their children through participation in meetings, prayer and regular participation in the Sunday Mass. A number of parishioners assisted with the preparation for Confirmation and/or First Holy Communion. We thank God for their willingness to share their gifts and time with others. BECOMING A MEMBER OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

Are you interested in becoming a full member of the Catholic Church? Do you know someone who is not baptized and wishes to become a member of Holy Family Parish? The preparation process includes prayer, catechesis (teaching) and worship with the parish community.

RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION The Body and Blood of Christ

Today our Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). The Church reminds us that we are to fast for one hour before receiving Holy Communion. Parents are encouraged to remind their children to dispose of gum and candies before entering the church.

At the time of Holy Communion, when the person in front of you has received Holy Communion and you are in the front of the procession, you will bow your head, the Minister of the Body of Christ will say, "**The Body of Christ**", and you will reply, "**Amen**". It is important to note that the only appropriate response is Amen. The church expects that Amen is said in a voice that can be heard by the Minister of Holy Communion. After saying Amen, you will consume the host immediately and if receiving the Precious Blood, you will move to the Minister of the Chalice, who will say, "**The Blood of Christ**", you will reply Amen and take a sip from the chalice. You will not bow a second time, for the act of receiving the Body and Blood of Christ is one ritual gesture. (GIRM, paragraph 160). Our Amen is absolutely necessary – the Church expects us to answer Amen to the Minister of Communion before we receive the Body/Blood of Christ.

All those who are free to receive Holy Communion are invited to receive both the Body and Blood of Christ. As a sign of our unity, we sing the Communion hymn and remain standing throughout the entire communion procession. We sit or kneel for silent prayer when the priest sits down after Communion.

The Canadian Bishops have instructed that our common sign of reverence be a bow of the head. This means that we do not genuflect or make the sign of the Cross before or after
