SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

Today's celebration of the Body and Blood of the Lord originated in the Diocese of Liege in 1246, as the Feast of Corpus Christi. In the reforms of Vatican II, Corpus Christi was joined with the feast of the Precious Blood (July 1st) to become the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of the Lord. Today, we celebrate Christ's gift to us of the Eucharist, the source and summit of our life together as the Church.

In the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, we read "the Eucharist is the primary source of the Church's energy for carrying out its mission in the world." (par. 10) Every time we share in Holy Communion, may we remember that is the union with God and union with our brothers and sisters, who eat and drink with us at the Lord's table. May we live as the one Body of Christ.

FAMILY MEALS AND PRAYER

When we gather at the table, we are prompted to give thanks to God. Praying before a meal is a time to thank God for the gifts of the day, including the food, to pray for ourselves, for those at the table and for the larger community. The following prayer is offered for your daily prayer:

O God, you dispel the darkness of our lives with the shining glory of the resurrection of your Son. Bless this food and drink which you provide for us, that being renewed in body and soul, we may serve you with holiness of life, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

STEWARDSHIP

The Scriptures today remind us that "we, many though we are, are one body for we all partake of the one loaf." How are we using our gifts of time and talent to build up the Body of Christ?
