The first chapter of St. Luke's Gospel tells us the story of John's birth. From Scripture, we know John and Jesus were relatives. John was a prophet who proclaimed the coming of the Messiah. We are familiar with the scripture story of John baptizing Jesus in the Jordan River. St. John the Baptist is called the prophet of the Most High, for he came before the Lord to prepare his way. 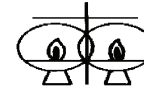
