SUGGESTIONS FOR THE THIRD WEEK OF LENT

The gospel today tells the story of Jesus' encounter at Jacob's well with the Samaritan woman. The church proclaims this passage from St. John's gospel as part of our preparation for Easter, when we will renew our baptismal promises.

During this week of Lent, you are invited to focus on water. Fresh clean water is not readily available to all people. You are invited to use a reusable water bottle and to reduce the length of your shower. We are encouraged to continue the practice of fasting. You may fast from your regular Friday evening activity and come to the parish at 7:30 pm and pray the Stations of the Cross. Remember to tie a ribbon on the branches for each Lenten practice you embrace.

Preparing for Easter

On the 3rd, 4th, 5th Sundays of Lent, we will celebrate a scrutiny with those who preparing for Baptism, are Confirmation and Eucharist at the Easter Vigil. The Church tells us that "The scrutinies are meant to uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective or sinful in the hearts of the elect; to bring out, then strengthen all that is upright, strong and good." As we journey through Lent, we are in solidarity with the Elect and reflect on how the interior of our hearts and lives need to be healed, so all that is good and upright may be strengthened. We continue to surround Emily, John, Elizabeth, Berkan, Celine and Lily with our pravers.

Also, we remember in prayer, **Annaliese and Angela**, who have been baptized and are preparing to complete their initiation and join us in sharing the Body and Blood of Christ. You are asked to pray daily for the elect and candidates as they prepare for initiation at Easter.
