SUGGESTIONS FOR THE THIRD WEEK OF LENT

The gospel today tells the story of Jesus' encounter at Jacob's well with the Samaritan woman. The Church proclaims this passage from St. John's Gospel as part of our preparation for Easter when we will renew our baptismal promises.

During this week of Lent, you are invited to focus on water. Fresh clean water is not readily available to all people. You are invited to use a reusable water bottle, to include a prayer of gratitude for the gift of water, find the date of your baptism and record it on your family/personal calendar and pray for those who are preparing for baptism. We are encouraged to continue the practice of fasting. Remember to tie a ribbon on the branches for each Lenten practice you embrace.

Preparing for Easter

On the 3rd, 4th, and 5th Sundays of Lent we celebrate a scrutiny with **Melanie and Julia** who are preparing for Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist at the Easter Vigil. The church tells us that, "The scrutinies are meant to uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective or sinful in the hearts of the elect; to bring out then strengthen all that is upright strong and good."

As we journey through Lent, we are in solidarity with the Elect and reflect on how the interior of our hearts and lives need to be healed so all that is good and upright may be strengthened. We continue to surround our elect, Melanie and Julia with our prayers.

We also remember in prayer, **Jacqui and Chris** who are baptized and are preparing to be received into Full Communion with the Catholic Church, be confirmed and join us at the table of the Lord.
