SUGGESTIONS FOR THE FOURTH WEEK OF LENT

The gospel today tells the story of the man born blind and his encounter with Jesus. Jesus is the light of the world and on the day of our baptism we are reminded that we are to keep the flame of faith burning brightly. This week find out the date of your baptism, mark it on your family calendar, so that you may celebrate this anniversary each year. Pray for those who brought you to be baptized and for those who have nurtured you in faith.

We are encouraged to continue the Lenten practices of prayer, fasting and giving. This week you may choose to pray for every cashier that you encounter, pray for the bus driver who takes you to and from school and pray for the safety of all travelers.

You may fast from complaining or stating what is wrong in the world; instead, feast on sharing some good news about your day and others. This week you may choose to give your time to someone else, do an errand or chore for your husband/wife; clear the table and do the dishes after a meal without being asked; turn off the television, computer or cell phone and read with your child, call a friend or family member just to say hello and ask them how they are - be sure to listen to them. Remember to tie a ribbon on the branches for each Lenten practice you embrace.

Preparing for Easter

Today, during the 10:00 am mass, we celebrate the second scrutiny with the elect. The Church tells us that "the scrutinies are meant to uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective or sinful in the hearts of the Elect; to bring out, then strengthen all that is upright strong and good." As we journey through Lent, we are in solidarity with the Elect and reflect on how the interior

of our hearts and lives need to be healed so all that is good and upright may be strengthened. We continue to surround Emily, John, Elizabeth, Berkan, Celine and Lily with our prayers

Also, we remember in prayer, Annaliese and Angela, who have been baptized and are preparing to complete their initiation and join us in sharing the Body and Blood of Christ. You are asked to pray daily for the elect and candidates as they prepare for initiation at Easter.
