SUGGESTIONS FOR THE FOURTH WEEK OF LENT

The gospel today tells the story of the man born blind and his encounter with Jesus. Jesus is the light of the world and on the day of our baptism we are reminded that we are to keep the flame of faith burning brightly. This week, find out the date of your baptism, mark it on your family calendar, or in your electronic calendar, so that you may celebrate this anniversary each year. Pray for those who brought you to be baptized and for those who have nurtured you in faith.

We are encouraged to continue the Lenten practices of prayer, fasting and giving. This week, you may choose to pray for every cashier that you encounter, pray for the bus driver who takes you to and from school and pray for the safety of all travelers.

You might fast from complaining or stating what is wrong in the world; instead, feast on sharing some good news about your day and others. This week, you might choose to give your time to someone else, do an errand or chore for your husband/wife; clear the table and do the dishes without being asked; turn off the television, computer, or cellphone and read with your child; call a friend, or family member just to say hello and ask them how they are – be sure to listen to them. Remember to tie a ribbon on the braches for each Lenten practice you embrace




