EASTER or PASCHAL TRIDUUM The Three Days

The Easter or Paschal Triduum (Triduum means three) are the most important days of the entire liturgical year. The season of Lent ends when we gather for the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday. It is not possible to find words to adequately explain the importance and significance of the Easter Triduum. The best way to understand is to join the Church in celebrating the liturgies of Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil. You are encouraged to set aside regular tasks or routines so that when you are not at church, your family can enjoy time together.

We will gather at the church at the following times;

Holy Thursday April 2nd, 8:00 pm The Mass of the Lord's Supper, washing of feet, collection of food Good Friday April 3rd, 12:00 noon OR 3:00 pm The Passion of Our Lord

Good Friday, 7:30 pm, Dramatic Presentation of the Stations of the Cross

Will B. 12.00 Mill B. 14.15 First Stations of the Cross

Holy Saturday, 12:00 noon Midday Prayer and Anointing of the Elect, the Blessing of Easter Baskets

Easter Vigil April 4th, 8:30 pm This is the highpoint of our liturgical year and we begin with the blessing of a new fire. A reception will be held in the parish hall after this liturgy.

Easter Sunday April 5th, 8:15 am, 10:00 am, 12:00 noon Easter Sunday Mass

Tuesday April 7th, 7:15 pm We will gather for an evening of conversation and reflection on the liturgies of the Easter Triduum – everyone is invited to attend.

As the Church gathers on Holy Thursday evening at 8:00 pm to celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper, the season of Lent ends quietly. As a Church, we leave the season of Lent and begin to celebrate the Easter Triduum.

PREPARING FOR EASTER

The Eater Triduum is the highpoint of our Church year. For a Catholic there is really nothing more important than gathering with the community to pray throughout these three days. liturgical day begins at sundown, so our first day is from sundown on Thursday to sundown on Friday. The second day is sundown on Friday to sundown on Saturday and the third day is sundown on Saturday to sundown on Sunday. The Easter Triduum is really one liturgy that extends over the three days. We go home in-between to rest, pray and to ponder the mystery of Jesus' life, death and resurrection.

We live in a world that seldom takes time off from work and daily demands, so it it important to plan how we can keep the Easter Triduum holy. 
