It was John who called 911, which led to his mom leaving the abusive situation, and it was that incident that got his family involved with our Safer Families Program. Through our domestic violence programming John learned that he was not the only kid who had this happening in his home, and most importantly, he learned that it was not his fault. He was able to get his feelings out, and learn new ways of coping, different from what he had witnessed in his home, so that he could have a chance at a different kind of life than that to which he had been exposed. Our network of Catholic Family Services offices collectively reach over 125,000 clients, serving them in more than 25 languages.
