In February 2015, Archbishop Cardinal Collins sent a letter to all pastors explaining that after consultation he has "decided for the Archdiocese of Toronto to change the elementary school grade for the candidates for Confirmation from 8 to 7. This will take effect September 8, 2015 in terms of the sacramental preparation."

The change instituted by Cardinal Collins will impact each parish in the Archdiocese. To facilitate effective communication, we shall be holding a meeting for all parents of young people currently enrolled in grades 6 and 7. The meeting will be held at Holy Family Parish on three different occasions. Each Parent is asked to attend one meeting.

Important information regarding the preparation process and dates for celebrating Confirmation in 2016 will be shared. Please make every effort to attend one of the meetings.


