## CELEBRATING INITIATION DURING EASTER

In the Church, the Easter season is the normative time for celebrating the Sacraments of Initiation, Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist.

At Holy Family Parish, between May 29<sup>th</sup> and June 8<sup>th</sup>, we will gather on eight occasions to celebrate Confirmation with 257 of our young people. Throughout Eastertime, with joy, we will welcome 166 young people to the Eucharistic Table for the first time. We pray for the families who are celebrating the Sacraments of Initiation and we thank God for their witness of faith.

#### **CELEBRATING CONFIRMATION**

Lectors, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, Altar Servers and Ministers of Hospitality are asked to 'sing up' to serve at one or more of the Confirmation celebrations. The list of dates is posted in the sacristy. All confirmation masses begin at 7:00 pm.

# RECEIVING HOLY COMMUNION A Sign of Our Communion With God and Union with Others

Beginning the third Sunday of Easter, children in our parish will share in Holy Communion for the first time. The children will sit with their families and participate fully in the entire celebration of Mass. It is always good for those of us who come to the table each week to pause and recall the proper way to receive Holy Communion.

At the time of Holy Communion, when the person in front of you has received Holy Communion and you are in the front of the procession, you will bow your head, the Minister of the Body of Christ will say, "The Body of Christ," you will reply, "Amen". It is important to note that the only appropriate response is *Amen*. The Church expects that *Amen* is said in a voice that can be heard by the Minister of Holy Communion.

After saying **Amen**, you will consume the host immediately and if receiving the Precious Blood, you will move to the Minister of the Chalice, who will say, "The Blood of Christ", the reply is "Amen" and take a sip from the chalice. You will not bow a second time, for the act of receiving the Body and Blood of Christ is one ritual gesture. (GIRM, paragraph 160)

The Canadian Bishops have instructed that our common sign of reverence be a bow of the head. As a sign of unity, we remain standing throughout the entire communion procession.

Singing the Communion hymn unites us in prayer. When the priest sits down after Communion, we sit or kneel for silent prayer.

Alleluia! Christ is risen.
Risen indeed. Alleluia!!

## THE GREAT FIFTY DAYS OF EASTER

We are encouraged to celebrate the entire season of Easter. Easter continues until June 5th, when we celebrate the feast of Pentecost. Children of all ages are happy to continue celebrating Easter with special activities such as baking cookies, planning a festive meal. sending a 'thinking of you card' (by Canada Post!), or email to godparents and relatives, or going for a walk and being grateful for the many signs of new life. When you gather for your family meal, you are invited to include a prayer of gratitude for the many gifts in your life, including the gift of Baptism.


