## CELEBRATING INITIATION DURING EASTER

In the Church, the Easter season is the normative time for celebrating the Sacraments of Initiation, Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist.

Throughout Eastertime, with joy, we will welcome 166 young people to the Eucharistic Table for the first time. 
