In February 2015, Archbishop Cardinal Collins sent a letter to all pastors explaining that after consultation he has "decided for the Archdiocese of Toronto to change the elementary school grade for the candidates for Confirmation from 8 to 7. This will take effect September 8, 2015 in terms of the sacramental preparation."

The change instituted by Cardinal Collins will impact each parish in the Archdiocese. To facilitate effective communication, we shall be holding a meeting for all parents of young people currently enrolled in grades 6 and 7. The meeting will be held at Holy Family Parish on three different occasions. Each Parent is asked to attend one meeting.

ORDINARY TIME

On Monday May 25th, 2015 we returned to the season of Ordinary Time. During Ordinary Time, the church celebrates the fullness of the mystery of the Lord Jesus. The people of God offer praise by celebrating the Paschal Mystery of the death and resurrection of Jesus." (Ordo, Liturgical Calendar, 2010-2011, CCCB, 2010)

Ordinary Time continues until the Church celebrates the Feast of Christ the King, this year on Sunday November 22, 2015. This period of time is neither a season of preparation such as Advent or Lent, nor a season of celebration such as Christmas or Easter. The season of Ordinary Time, especially the Sundays, are devoted to the mystery of Christ in all its aspects.

The weekly celebration of Sunday Eucharist is a hallmark of a Catholic way of life. Gathering each Sunday throughout Ordinary time shapes and forms us as the Body of Christ in all its aspects.

There is really nothing 'ordinary' about this time, for like all of time, it belongs to God. As faithful disciples, we strive to live our lives rooted in God's presence aware that through the rhythm of daily life, we encounter God in the amazingly ordinary parts of our day. Ordinary Time reminds us that our God came and lived among us, wedding humanity and divinity for ever.


