TRINITY SUNDAY

Today, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. This is one of the few days in the liturgical year that we celebrate a doctrine and belief, rather than an event (i.e. Easter Sunday or Christmas) or a person (i.e. St. Joseph or Mary the Mother of God).

Today, we celebrate our eternal God: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. Two prayers that embody our belief in the Trinity are: the Sign of the Cross and the Glory Be. Trinity Sunday is always celebrated on the first Sunday after Pentecost.

We continue to welcome the children who have been prepared by their families to share in Holy Communion for the first time. We pray for them and we thank God for their witness of faith.

CELEBRATING CONFIRMATION An Important Reminder

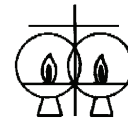
CHURCH PARKING
