There will be adult members of our parish who will lead the Liturgy with the children. The Priest invites the children after the Opening Prayer and before the Liturgy of the Word begins. The children return to the main assembly and their families during the Preparation of the Gifts. The Liturgy of the Word with children will not be celebrated weekly, rather we shall schedule times in harmony with the liturgical calendar and the parish schedule. We shall celebrate the Liturgy of the Word with children between the ages of four and eight, on Sunday May 13th, during the 10:00 am and 12 noon liturgies.
