Today, Sunday November 30th, the Church enters a new liturgical year. The Church has a three year cycle which we follow. We are now entering Year 'B'. Throughout this year, the Gospel passage on Sunday is most often from the shortest gospel, that of St. Mark. This gospel is the first gospel that was written and presents a challenging portrait of Jesus' public ministry. Jesus is presented as a wise teacher and a compassionate healer. In St. Mark's gospel we are called to confront the mystery of the cross.

The Church reminds us that "Advent has a twofold character, for it is a time of preparation for the Solemnities of Christmas, in which the first coming of the Son of God to humanity is remembered, and likewise a time when. by remembrance of this, minds and hearts are led to look forward to Christ's Second Coming at the end of time. For these two reasons, Advent is a period of devout and expectant delight." Universal Norms on the Liturgical Year and the General Roman Calendar, par. 39. During Advent we are reminded that we are to be ready to welcome Christ in our brothers and sisters and to prepare to celebrate the mystery of the Incarnation: God with us.
