YEAR OF FAITH!

During the Year of Faith, we are invited to deepen our relationship with God. Families are invited to pray together before their meal and at the end of the day. From the earliest days of the Church, Christians have prayed for the dead. November begins with the Feast of All Saints and

All Souls. For many, November has become a time to remember in a particular way, those who have died. Although the falling leaves and shorter days can create a picture of death, we know that Jesus in his resurrection has destroyed death for all time. During this month, you are invited to light a candle when you gather for a meal or family prayer and to include a prayer for those who have died, including those who have no one to pray for them. A traditional prayer for those who have died is:

Eternal rest grant unto them O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May their souls and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.
