Hungarian Holocaust survivor Leslie Meisels will speak about his personal experiences during the Holocaust. Leslie Meisels was born in Nádudvar, Hungary in 1927. He lived with his parents, two brothers and both sets of grandparents. He survived the ghettos in Nádudvar and Debrecen, slave labour in Austria and the eventual deportation to Bergen-Belsen concentration camp. He was liberated in April 1945 by the 9th US Army from a death train.
