PREPARING TO CELEBRATE CONFIRMATION AND FIRST COMMUNION Vital Information for All Families

The Church takes the preparation for and celebration of the sacraments very seriously because these celebrations are of the utmost importance in the life of the Church and each of its members. Weekly participation in Sunday (Saturday) Mass is a normal expectation for all Catholics.

At the time of baptism, parents declare their intention to assume responsibility as the first teachers of their children in the ways of the faith. The local church (the parish) assists the parents in their vocation and the Catholic schools provide education in a setting where Catholic Christian values are taught and reflected throughout the day.

The immediate preparation for the sacraments takes place at Holy Family Parish. All parents/guardians wishing to prepare their child to celebrate Confirmation or First Communion are asked to attend an important information meeting. Details regarding the registration, dates for the celebration of the sacraments and date of future gatherings will be shared at the meeting. All meetings will be held in the church. To accommodate family schedules, each meeting is offered twice; you are to attend one of the two meetings. If you have a child preparing to celebrate Confirmation and another child ready to celebrate First Communion, you will need to attend two meetings, as the preparation process is different. If your child was not baptized in the Catholic Church and he/she wishes to be confirmed or celebrate First Communion, at your earliest convenience, please contact Catherine Ecker, parish catechist, at 905-857-1938, or by email: Catherine.ecker@hollyfamilybolton.ca.

Confirmation

If your child was baptized in the Roman Catholic Church and born in 2000, or earlier, and you wish to prepare your child to celebrate Confirmation, please attend one of the Parent and Candidate Information Meetings on Sunday, September 15th, 2:00 - 3:30pm, **OR**, Thursday September 26th, 7:30 - 9:00 pm. It is very important that you and you son/daughter attend the information meeting.

First Communion

If your child was baptized in the Roman Catholic Church and born in 2006 or earlier, and you wish to prepare your child to celebrate First Communion, please attend one of the Parent Information Meetings on: Thursday, September 12th, 7:30 - 9:00 pm, **OR**, Sunday, September 29th, 2:00 - 3:30 pm. To allow for your full participation, you are encouraged to arrange child care. It is very important that you attend the information meeting.
