MEETINGS REGARDING THE PREPARATION FOR FIRST COMMUNION

Vital Information

The immediate preparation for the sacraments takes place at Holy Family Parish. All parents/guardians wishing to prepare their child to celebrate Confirmation or First Communion are asked to attend an important information meeting. Details regarding the registration, dates for the celebration of the sacraments and date of future gatherings will be shared at the meeting. *All meetings will be held in the church.* To accommodate family schedules, each meeting is offered twice; you are to attend one of the two meetings. If you have a child preparing to celebrate Confirmation and another child ready to celebrate First Communion, you will need to attend two meetings, as the preparation process is different.

First Communion

If your child was baptized in the Roman Catholic Church and born in 2006 or earlier, and you wish to prepare your child to celebrate First Communion, please attend the Parent Information Meeting on Sunday, September 29th, 2:00 – 3:30 pm. To allow for your full participation, you are encouraged to arrange child care. **It is very important** that you attend the information meeting.

None other than St. Ambrose, one of the original four doctors of the Church, drew a comparison between Baptism and Reconciliation: "There are water and tears; the water of Baptism and the tears of repentance. We, too, need to strive to hear "Your faith has saved you; go in peace."




